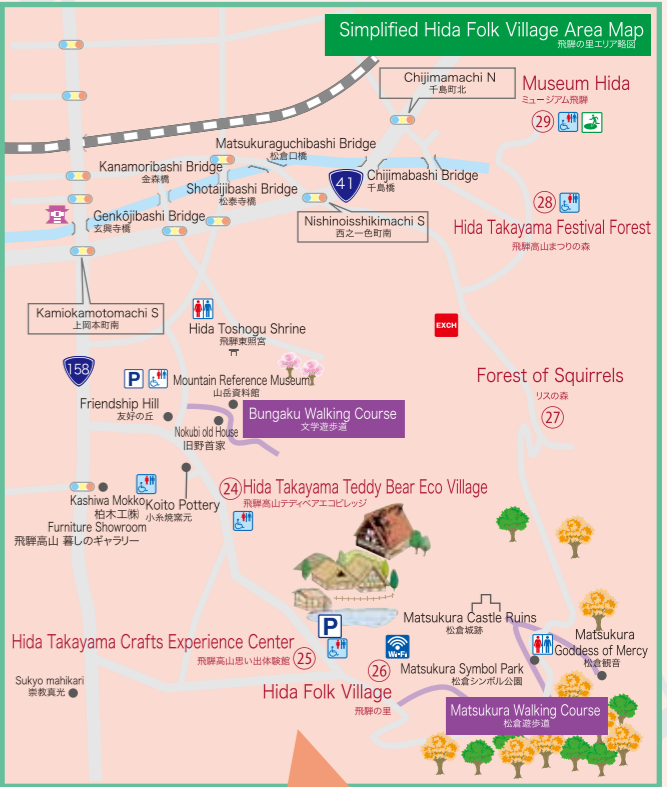
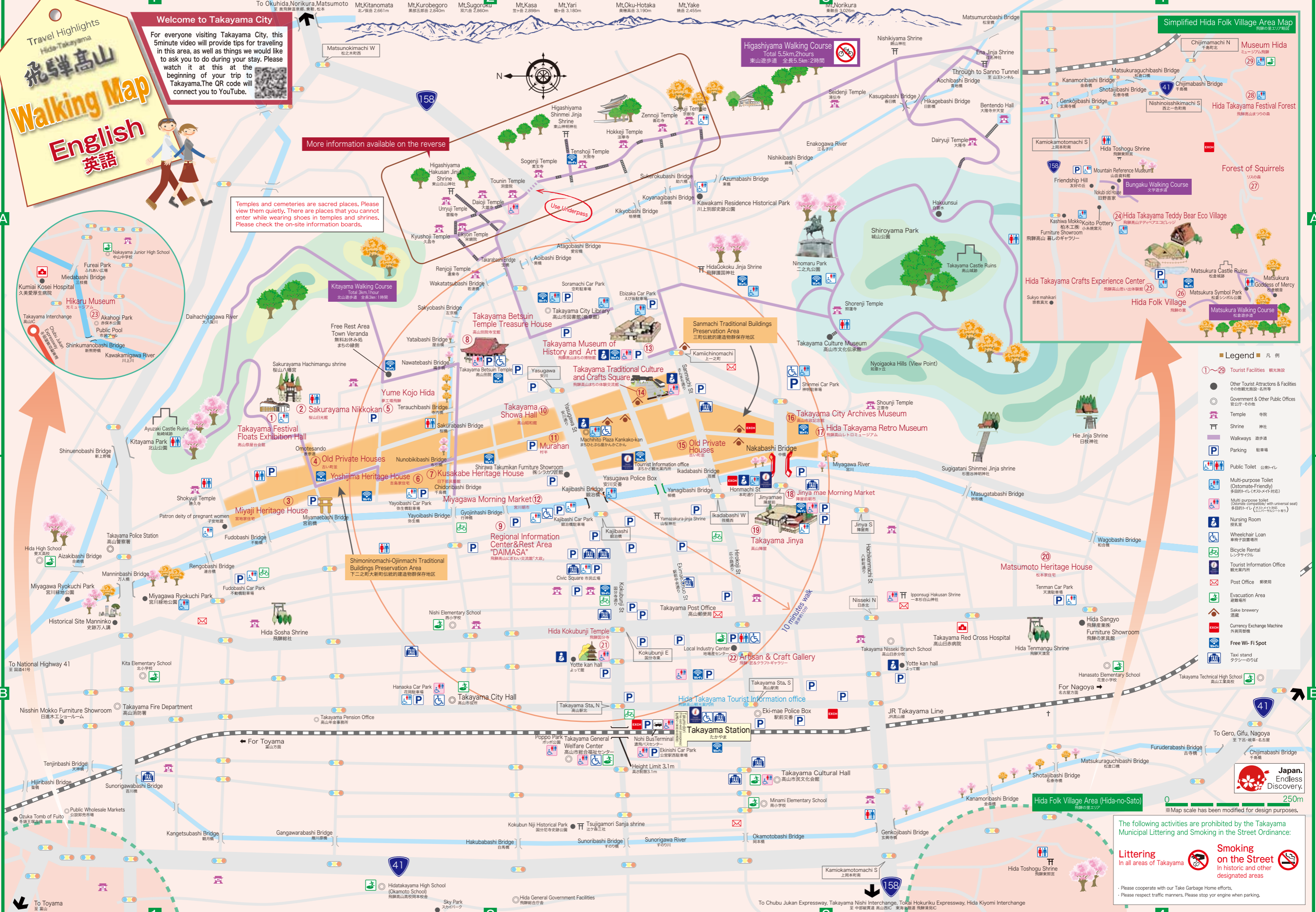
Temples and cemeteries are sacred places. Please view them quietly. There are places that you cannot enter while wearing shoes in temples and shrines. Please check the on-site information boards.

Even today one can find Sakabayashi hanging from the eaves of sake distilleries, the front shutters marking merchant's houses and the continuing tradition of old establishments.

Feel the Historic Landscape on this Takayama Route Higashiyama walking course (Near Teramachi)

The town of Takayama was founded during the 107-year reign of the 6-generation Kanamori dynasty that began when Nagachika Kanamori subjugated Hida at the command of Hideyoshi Toyotomi during the Warring States period. Kanamori established and transferred many temples on the ridge on the East of Takayama, taking his cue from Kyoto's Higashiyama. These temples and shrines, the graves of the famous people related to Takayama in the graveyards of those temples, and other prefectural and municipal designated cultural assets can be visited on the Higashiyama walking trail.

The Higashiyama Walking Course is a route that takes you through the grounds of temples and shrines. Therefore, please be aware of the following points while walking:

- Please walk quietly in the grounds of temples and shrines.
- Never drop or throw away trash.
- If there is a cobblestone path, please use it.

Soyuji Temple was established by two brothers Shigeyori and Shigekatsu (Sakyo), the third generation of the Kanamori dynasty, in 1632 to pray for the salvation of their father Yoshishige. In the garden, which lies behind the building on the east side, one can partake of the famous aesthetic of the Kanamori Clan style garden with its stepping stones, rocks piled on mountain side, low to mid-sized cropped trees and the overall composition of the elements. This is a prime example of the advanced and refined Takayama samurai family culture. Each year the garden of Soyuji Temple is opened to the public on special days.

* The Higashiyama walking course includes many precious cultural assets. Please be respectful when visiting these locations.
