### [Places of worship]

• There are facilities that provide prayer space.

#### [Wudu]

- Since there are few dedicated facilities for Wudu in Japan, it is advisable to perform Wudu before going out.
- When performing Wudu in Japan, please be careful not to splash water too much in the washing area. Please take care so that the next person can also use the place comfortably.

#### [Food & drink]

- There are many Japanese dishes that you can eat without anxiety such as sushi, tempura, soba (buckwheat noodles), udon (wheat noodles), fish and shellfish, etc.
- "Mirin" (sweet cooking rice wine) is a common seasoning (alcohol) used in Japanese food. However, it evaporates when cooked.

#### **(Souvenirs)**

• Some souvenirs contain lard, gelatin or emulsifier (shortening) with a pig-derived ingredient.

### [Restrooms]


• Toilets equipped with an automatic cleaning function (bidet) can be found almost everywhere in Japan. At the push of a button, water is sprayed automatically for cleansing.


### [Public baths/hot springs]

• In a Japanese public bath, you take off all your clothes to take a bath. In principle, it is not allowed to have your swimsuit on or a towel around your body.


